

**WORD OF GOD FELLOWSHIP, INC.**  
**Application for License Renewal**

**PURPOSE OF AMENDMENT**

The purpose of this amendment is to disclose that, during the most recent license term, television station WDPM-DT, Mobile, Alabama (“Station”) provided viewers in its community of license and the surrounding areas with excellent public affairs programming aimed at diverse audiences, including news, weather, emergency information and other important current events, as set forth on the Station’s quarterly issues/programs lists.

However, due to administrative oversight (in large part caused by the vagaries of the Commission’s OPIF system, where uploading errors are common), the Station’s issues/programs lists for 2Q 2015, 4Q 2016, 2Q 2017, and 1Q 2019, and the Station’s 3Q 2015 and 2Q 2017 commercial limit certifications were not uploaded on time to the Station’s online public inspection file (“OPIF”). However, importantly, Word of God Fellowship, Inc. (“WOGF”), the licensee of the Station, has not received any queries or complaints from any member of the public concerning the Station’s programming, the commercials included during children’s programming, or any other contents of the Station’s OPIF associated with any quarter in which the issues/programs lists or commercial limits certifications were uploaded late (or, indeed, during any part of the Station’s most recent license term). As set forth herein, the reported error was simply ministerial. In addition, it should be noted that WOGF has uploaded to the Station’s OPIF the issues/programs lists and the commercial limits certifications on time **during every other quarter/year** of the Station’s preceding eight-year license term.

WOGF has revised its response to the “Online Public Inspection File” item from “Yes” to “No.”

In summary, WOGF has been in compliance with the Commission’s rules during the Station’s preceding license term. Accordingly, WOGF submits that no Commission action is warranted, and that grant of this license renewal application would serve the public interest, convenience and necessity.
