

Advancement of FCC Educational Program Supplement

This exhibit is to further demonstrate Playhouse Art's radio station's educational objectives and that the proposed radio station will be used for the advancement of an educational program under 73.503(a) of the Rules.

Playhouse Arts incorporated in the state of California on May 21st 2007.

Since 2021, as a program of Playhouse Arts, Humboldt Hot Air has been operating as an internet-only radio station serving Humboldt County CA and the surrounding region with an emphasis on the arts. The purpose of Playhouse Arts is to use the arts as a tool to build a community that is inspired and empowered to work together for the common good, and Humboldt Hot Air has been pushing this purpose forward. With over 60 volunteer DJs, 100% of whom are programming live from our Arcata studio, Humboldt Hot Air aims to amplify the diverse voices we have in our community. As a Low Power FM radio station, Humboldt Hot Air will dig deeper, reach further, and strengthen the connections that have already begun to blossom. Our goals with becoming an LPFM include:

- Creating a radio station that deeply reflects the community, with voices of friends and neighbors sharing with each other their knowledge, to support a community that is united and informed.
- Develop a platform that contains critical information to the surrounding community, and to support that community in times of crisis with up to date information sharing.
- Continue to be an accessible platform for people from all walks of life. A place where the different corners of our community can come together to share culture and information.
- To promote skill sharing and training that could eventually lead to employment

Sample programming includes:

“Starfish Radio Hour,” with Shoshanna Rose in collaboration with the Humboldt County Library: Humboldt County Library invites families everywhere to tune into a weekly radio program hosted by Shoshanna featuring songs and stories. Each week has a different theme and showcases items from our library collection, local musicians and storytellers, and news about upcoming events

“Art Attitude” with Wendy Butler: Tune in for conversations with visual, performing and literary artists as well as news and commentary about art’s role in all things, and how art connects and strengthens community.

“The Black Humboldt Takeover” with Black Humboldt: Takeover from local organization, Black Humboldt. Featuring local Black voices and music with rotating DJs
