

Established Community Presence: Board Members' Residences

As documented in the Exhibit titled "Qualified LPFM Applicant and Established Community Presence," for a period of at least two years prior to the date of this application, the applicant, Clinton County Amateur Radio Association ("CCARA"), has existed as a nonprofit educational institution or organization.

One hundred percent of CCARA's board members have resided for at least two years within 32.1 kilometers (20 miles) (the radius for markets outside the top 50 urban markets, as applicable here) from the proposed transmitting antenna site of the proposed LPFM (transmitter site marked as "LPFM watertank"). See attached map (larger red circle marks 32.1 kilometers/20 miles from the proposed LPFM transmitter site).
