1) The organization state of incorporation and date.

Citizens Against Unfair Financial Practices is incorporated in the State of Tennessee as a 501(c) (3) organization established on 10/22/2008.

2) The organization's educational purpose.

The mission and goal of CAUFP is simple; to educate and empower the listeners through radio programs that will help influence the hearts and minds of the community.

3) Detailed descriptions of proposed programming and and a program schedule.

These programs will be promoted Bilingually to help English and Spanish speaking citizens be engaged in our content to address issue relating to the community we serve.

Live programming will run 24 hours a day. We pledge to locally produce at least 8 hours of local programming per day: 7 days a week.

Sample Shows for broadcasting.

Show: How To Manage Your Medical Bills.

This program will air Saturdays and Sunday at 12PM for 30 min.

The discussion will contain the subject matter of Medical Expenses, and how to address them, with a panel of existing working providers in the area.

The panels discussion will contain what to expect from admission to discharge, and expenses and terms of payment if no coverage is available. Options for grant and provider medical assistance if available. The objective is to inform the family and patient on what to expect and what expectations and types of actions can help promote for a better outcome.

We will discuss types of coverage and some of the differences in outcomes that exist between Governmental and Commercial Policies.

Show: Manage Your Priorities.

This Program will air Saturday and Sunday at 4pm for 30 min.

The discussion will contain a panel of financial advisers and recovery team members to discuss warning signs and pitfalls most consumers face with paycheck to paycheck living.

The panels discussion will cover expected outcomes to some of the most problematic scenarios that exist in todays communities, and how to avoid or overcome them.

The panel will offer guidance and optional resources to help overcome or soften these types of financial obstacles in helping to guide for a better outcome.

Show: This weeks in the Know:

This program will Air Monday to Friday at 5pm for 30 min.

The discussion will cover programs currently available in the community for help and assistance.

The panel will discuss events being promoted to help and assist for all facets of community workflow and Life Balance experiences.

This show will invite local companies leadership teams to discuss their commitment to enhance the wellbeing of the community through outreach programs. We will discuss events and programs available and the expected outcome.

4) How the programming will advance our educational purpose.

Including a radio station will enhance our mission by educating the community with diversity that doesn't exist presently by enhancing knowledge and education about the ethnicities, perspectives and voices present in the Memphis area. These shows will emphasize events that are going on in our area and community news, educate the community on topics that are particularly important to the diverse cultural groups, share local and authentic music and increase awareness about opportunities for our community members to get involved in the community or enhance their life.
