EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVE

The Applicant is an nonprofit Delaware corporation, incorporated in 2023. Its educational objectives include the following:

Subject matter covered by programming will include family development, child rearing and education, health information and religion. Programs will be developed and selected so as to be responsive to the needs and interests in the proposed service area.

CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

CHRISTIAN FELLOWSHIP, INC.**

ARTICLE 1

Name

The name of the corporation is Christian Fellowship, Inc.

ARTICLE 2

Effective Date

The effective date of incorporation shall be upon filing by the Secretary of State.

ARTICLE 3

Existence

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE 4

Fiscal Year

The corporation's fiscal year shall close on each December 31.

ARTICLE 5

Type of Nonprofit Corporation

The corporation is organized not for profit.
The corporation shall not have any capital stock.

ARTICLE 6

Members

The corporation will have members.
Conditions of membership, if any, shall be stated in the corporation's bylaws.

ARTICLE 7

Registered Agent and Office

The name of the corporation's initial registered agent is Corporation Service Company, whose street address and mailing address is 251 Little Falls Drive, Wilmington, DE 19808 (which is located in New Castle County).

ARTICLE 9

Indemnification

The corporation shall indemnify any directors, officers, employees, incorporators, and members of the corporation from any liability regarding the corporation and the affairs of the corporation, unless such person fraudulently and intentionally violated the law and/or maliciously conducted acts to damage and/or defraud the corporation, or as otherwise provided under applicable statute.

ARTICLE 10

Purposes

The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including for such purposes the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of the United States, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax law, and including but not limited to the ownership and/or operation of one or more noncommercial educational broadcast stations in order to provide broadcast programming that will inform, educate and uplift the public.

ARTICLE 11

Prohibited Activities

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article 10. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise

attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.


ARTICLE 12 Distributions upon Dissolution

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all legal liabilities of the corporation, the corporation's assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of the United States or the corresponding section of any future federal tax law, or such assets shall be distributed to the federal government or to a state or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

Christian Fellowship is an educational non-profit located at 5302 Mitchell Ave. in St. Joseph, MO. They propose to locate an LPFM antenna on their roof at N39 45 17.4" W94 46 16.1" NAD 83 datum. Two board members reside in Buchanan County where the antenna site is located and the third board member resides in DeKalb County. Neither county is listed in a top 50 market and all three board members reside within a 20-mile radius of the proposed antenna site, the green circle on the map.
