ONE: The name of this corporation is
Centro Cristiano de Sanidad Bethel.

TWO: This corporation is a nonprofit
religious corporation and is not
organized for the private gain of any
person. It is organized under the Nonprofit Religious Corporation Law
primarily for religious purposes. The specific purposes for which
this corporation is organized are to establish and maintain a church
for religious worship, to establish radio and television programs
which will extend the church's outreach, to support missionary
workers who will spread the gospel of Jesus Christ, to establish
schools in order to promote the study of the Bible (without
discrimination against students or applicants on the basis of race,
color, or national or ethnic origin), to ordain pastors, evangelists,
and missionaries.

THREE: The name and address in the State of California of this
corporation's initial agent for service of process is Ronald S.
Brown, 2278 E. Oakland Ave., Hemet, CA 92544.

- FOUR:
- (a) This corporation is organized and operated
exclusively for religious purposes within the
meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal
Revenue Code.
 - (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of these
Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any
other activities not permitted to be carried on (1)
by a corporation exempt from federal income tax
under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue
Code or (2) by a corporation contributions to which
are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the
Internal Revenue Code.
 - (c) No substantial part of the activities of this
corporation shall consist of carrying on
propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence
legislation, and the corporation shall not
participate or intervene in any political campaign
(including the publishing or distribution of
statements) on behalf of, or in opposition to, any
candidate for public office.

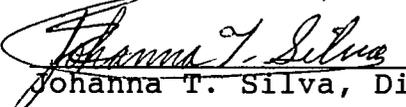

SIX: The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to religious purposes and no part of the net income or assets of the organization shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member thereof or to the benefit of any private person. On the dissolution or winding up of the corporation, its assets remaining after payment of, or provision for payment of, all debts and liabilities of this corporation, shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for religious purposes and which has established its tax-exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

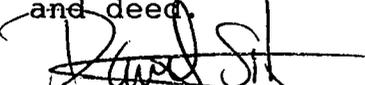

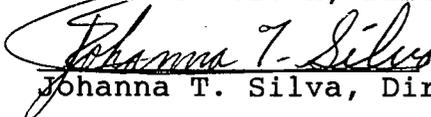
