Online Public Inspection File Certification

WPXI, LLC is the current licensee of WPXI (TV) (the “Station”). On December 17, 2019, the license for WPXI(TV) was transferred to the station’s current owner (“CMG”) pursuant to a long-form transfer of control application. *See* FCC File No. BTCCDT-20190304AEQ. To CMG’s knowledge, since ownership of the station was transferred, except as otherwise disclosed herein, CMG has timely placed in the station’s online public inspection file all documents required to be placed in the file pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 73.3526 and otherwise has complied with the Commission’s public inspection file requirements in all material respects. While CMG is not responsible for late public file uploads under the prior owners, in an abundance of caution, CMG notes that the EEO Public File Reports for 2016 and 2019 were uploaded late.

CMG requires its stations to comply with all applicable FCC rules, including the rules for the political public file. CMG employees are trained on FCC political public file compliance and CMG has processes in place under which station political public files are reviewed for completeness and timeliness. Nevertheless, while the Station has substantially complied with the political public file requirements, a few documents may have been uploaded to the political public file outside of CMG’s requirement that all documents be uploaded within one business day. CMG will continue to work with its stations to ensure that all political public file materials are uploaded in a timely manner.
