

Public Inspection File

Issues/Programs Reports. During the course of preparing the instant renewal application, it was discovered that WFPA-CD, Philadelphia, PA, Facility ID No. 74216 (the “Station”) inadvertently listed the call sign of WUVP-DT (which is under common ownership with, and is part of the same station employment unit as, the Station) on two of its quarterly issues/programs reports that were timely uploaded to the Station’s online public inspection file (“OPIF”). Immediately upon discovery, amended versions of these reports to reflect the Station’s call sign were uploaded to the Station’s OPIF.

Political File. The Station believes that it has generally met the requirement in Section 73.1943(c) of the FCC rules to post political orders to the online public inspection file “immediately, absent unusual circumstances.” The Station is aware of only two instances in which orders were not posted “immediately,” as interpreted by the FCC. In one of these cases, materials were uploaded seven days after the initial order was placed, and before the advertisements subject to the order had run in completion. In the other case, materials were uploaded eighteen days after the initial order was placed, and before the advertisements subject to the order had commenced airing on the Station.
