Dear Mr. Harding:

Spokane Television, Inc., licensee of Station KXLY-TV, Spokane, Washington (the "Station"), by counsel, hereby notifies the Commission that as of January 14, 2024, the Station has been forced to reduce its normal transmitter output power on its digital replacement translator due to abnormally high reflected power at the antenna. Station has engaged a tower crew to evaluate the situation and to recommend next steps. Station will work expeditiously to complete all needed repairs, and if such repairs are not finished after 30 days (i.e., by February 13, 2024), Station will file a request for special temporary authority to continue operating at reduced power.
