EXHIBIT RE: REBUTTING PRESUMPTION
OF TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION

On November 20, 2023, the Commission granted an application for a license to cover associated with this Station (File No. 0000226586), which specified use by the Station of a location owned by American Tower Corporation (“ATC”) at Cream Ridge, New Jersey (ASR No. 1052983) (“ATC Site”). Word of God Fellowship, Inc. (“WOGF”) was and remains mindful of the admonition set forth on the face of the Station’s license, indicating that operation of the Station from the ATC Site was required for twelve consecutive months, unless WOGF is able to rebut the presumption that the authorized facilities were only “temporarily” constructed.

WOGF is able to rebut that presumption, and can confirm that the construction of the facilities at the ATC Site was not intended to be temporary. On March 13, 2023, WOGF executed a Lease with ATC for use of the ATC Site (copy attached), and ATC counter-signed such Lease on May 12, 2023. The Lease specified a 6-month period because the parties expected to enter into a longer-term lease at the end of that 6-month period. ATC then completed construction of the Station from the ATC Site in mid-November 2023. Attached are photos of the installation of the facilities, including the Station’s antenna, transmitter and satellite dish, as well as confirmation of on-air operations.

However, WOGF subsequently made the determination that the site set forth in this application for minor modification would serve a greater population than was proposed to be served from the ATC Site. Accordingly, despite fully building out the Station’s facilities from the ATC Site as confirmed by the attachments to this amendment, WOGF ultimately elected to pursue operating the Station from the site set forth in this application.

Based on the foregoing, WOGF is able to rebut the presumption that the facilities were constructed from the ATC Site on only a temporary basis, and grant of this application would serve the public interest, convenience and necessity.
