The undersigned, all of whom are citizens of the United States, for the purpose of forming a charitable corporation not for profit pursuant to provisions of the Non-Profit Corporation Law of the State of Ohio (Section 1702.01 (B)) of the Revised Code of Ohio, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

- FIRST, The name of said corporation shall be
- VICTORY BAPTIST CHURCH OF SPRINGFIELD TOWNSHIP, OHIO.
- SECOND, the place in this State where the principal office of the corporation is to be located is
- Springfield Township, Clark County, Ohio.
- THIRD, the purpose or purposes for which said corporation is formed is:
- "To promote the Kingdom of God according to the Scriptures, provide religious instruction, and maintain public worship, to advance religious education and training. Without limitation upon the foregoing the corporation will have the power to acquire and hold title in fee simple, in trust or otherwise, to both real and personal property, and to approve, encumber, sell and convey, and dispose of all such property; erect and maintain buildings for the worship of God for training in christian faith and conduct, for promoting the cause of christian religion in the interests of said Church and to acquire, build and maintain residences for the use and occupancy of its Minister; to receive, hold and disburse gifts and bequests and funds arising from any source.

or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, nor shall the corporation participate in, or intervene in (including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office; nor shall this corporation engage in any transaction, accumulation of funds, or any other activity prohibited to any tax exempt charitable, scientific and educational organization at such time by the Internal Revenue Laws of the United States of America, or the laws of the State of Ohio or any other state where the activities of this Corporation are conducted.

No part of the net earnings of this Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any trustee, officer, or private individual, except as reasonable compensation for services rendered, goods received, or in exchange for property or valuable consideration which may be acquired by the Corporation for the accomplishment of its purposes.

Upon termination or dissolution all the remaining assets of this Corporation shall be distributed, transferred, and conveyed, to organizations which are organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes which qualify under the provisions of Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of the United States or acts amendatory thereof or supplementary thereto.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not conduct or carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization exempt under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 and the regulations promulgated thereunder, as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended.

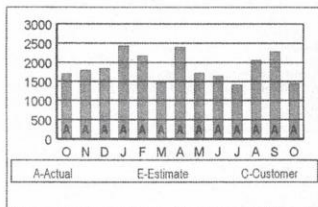
