Tribune Television Inc. (“Tribune Television”), licensee of WPHL-DT, has mounted WPHL’s DTV antenna on a 1100 foot antenna supporting structure recently constructed and owned by American Tower, L.P. (“ATC”) (ASR No. 1231524). That structure is located within 3.2 kilometers of the antenna supporting structures of Station WNWR(AM), Philadelphia PA, a directional AM station. Accordingly, Tribune Television’s DTV construction permit contained a condition that tracks Section 73.1692(d) of the FCC’s rules and requires Tribune Television to take various actions to ensure that WNWR’s AM array has not been adversely affected by the construction of the ATC structure and/or the mounting of WPHL-DT’s antenna.

To assure compliance with Section 73.1692(d) of the FCC’s Rules and to satisfy similar conditions in the construction permits of all of its tenants, ATC has entered into an Agreement with WNWR, dated August 11, 2001 (the “Agreement”), which provides for the mutual assessment, by ATC and WNWR, of the impact of ATC’s construction on WNWR’s pattern and prescribes procedures for the taking of measurements before, during, and after the construction of the ATC structure and the mounting of antennas on it; the allocation of costs related to those measurements, partial proofs of performance; and any modifications to WNWR's signal pattern and/or operating power that ATC and WNWR have agreed may be required to eliminate prohibited signal overlap arising from

re-radiation of the WNWR signal due to such construction. The terms of the Agreement prohibit ATC from sharing copies of the Agreement with its tenants.

Tribune Television understands from ATC that, pursuant to the Agreement, so-called before measurements have already been taken on WNWR's array. In addition, Tribune understands from ATC, again pursuant to the Agreement, so-called after measurements will be taken on WNWR's array once the ATC structure is complete and the transmission lines and antennas for all the ATC's tenants have been installed on the structure. Tribune Television submits that the Agreement between WNWR and ATC and the mechanism that it established to resolve any adverse impacts on WSWR's operations from the construction of the ATC structure and the mounting of WPHL's DTV antenna is sufficient to satisfy the WSWR condition in its construction permit.
