**Re: Request for Tolling of Construction Permit - File No. BNPFT-20130823AAY
Station W278BP, Palm Coast, FL (FCC Facility ID No. 157073)**

Dear Ms. Dortch:

On behalf of Central Florida Educational Foundation, Inc. ("Central Florida Educational Foundation"), permittee of the above-referenced FM translator station, this letter is submitted to the Commission to request tolling of the October 29, 2016 expiration date for the above-referenced construction permit (the "Permit").

Section 73.3598(b)(1) instructs that the period of construction for a construction permit shall toll when construction is prevented due to an act of God, defined in terms of natural disasters (*e.g.*, floods, tornadoes, hurricanes, or earthquakes).

Central Florida Educational Foundation is unable to complete construction at its current site due to the effects of Hurricane Matthew. Flagler County, Florida, the county in which the FM translator's tower site is located, was hit hard by Hurricane Matthew. All available construction and maintenance resources in the area have been diverted towards relief efforts as President Obama declared the entire county a disaster area on October 6, 2016. Accordingly, Central Florida Educational Foundation has been unable to secure a tower crew to complete construction of its facilities pursuant to the Permit.

Therefore, tolling of the Permit is requested, and should continue until a tower crew can be scheduled in light of the hurricane relief efforts currently underway in Flagler County, Florida.
