

EXHIBIT 2

The purpose of this exhibit is to illustrate the Sacramento Bicycle Kitchen's educational objective and that the proposed radio station will be used for the advancement of an educational program under 73.503(a) of the rules. The rules describe that noncommercial licenses are not limited to classroom instruction, but may "transmit educational, cultural, and entertainment program to the general public," (Section 73.503(b)) in the advancement of a radio program. The following clearly demonstrates the Sacramento Bicycle Kitchen's eligibility:

EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVE

The Sacramento Bicycle Kitchen is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization created in 2006. The Sacramento Bicycle Kitchen is a community-centered bicycle shop serving the residents of Sacramento, California. The organization was formed in order to promote cycling as a low-cost, alternative form of transportation; enable self-sufficiency through knowledge of bicycle maintenance; and promote bicycle safety through education and classes. Additionally the Sacramento Bicycle Kitchen also offers maintenance and safety courses and community outreach projects. The organization's objective is well in-line with the qualification of being considered an educational nonprofit.

PAST EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMS

The Sacramento Bicycle Kitchen has played a major role in educating the Sacramento Capitol region about cycling through classes, workshops, exhibitions and other educational outreach programs. The Sacramento Bicycle Kitchen has:

- Helped build a thriving community in Oak Park, (the Sacramento Bicycle Kitchen's original location) a historic neighborhood that has been recovering from devastating economic depression.
- Repeatedly supported the local independent art scene by offering its space for local artists and musicians to perform showcase their work at city events such as the 2nd Saturday Art Walk.
- Placed an emphasis on children's education by hosting regular Kid's Nights to give children the opportunity to learn how to be self-reliant, work on their own bicycles and to also introduce them to alternative and environmentally friendly forms of transportation.

PROPOSED EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM

The Sacramento Bicycle Kitchen intends to utilize the proposed facility to extend its educational mission to the airwaves by carrying:

- public affairs programming dealing with bicycle maintenance, alternative forms of transportation, local art, local music, local history and current local and international affairs.
- a wide range of independent musical programming with an emphasis on local groups and genres that may appeal to Sacramento's diverse, multi-cultural community.
- create and to broadcast educational programs, particularly those that substantially affecting the public, promote cultural diversity, and give a voice to the community.

The radio program will basically expand its current program to fully actualize its original intent prescribed in its mission and to also branch out beyond topics of bicycles and transportations as well.
