SUMMARY

This engineering report is submitted on behalf of Nassau Broadcasting II, LLC ("Nassau") in support of an application by Nassau to acquire station WILT(AM). WILT is licensed to Mount Pocono, Pennsylvania. This report demonstrates that Nassau's application complies with the applicable technical multiple ownership provisions of Section 73.3555 of the Commission's rules as they pertain to number of stations in market.

DEFINITION OF THE "MARKET"

Under the current FCC ownership rules, a "market" is defined as the area encompassed by the overlapping principal community contours of the stations for which common ownership is proposed. Accordingly, a study has been conducted on the locations of the principal community contours of WILT and all pertinent Nassau owned or operated stations. A mapping of this study is provided in Figure 1.

The WILT "market" represented in Figure 1 consists of three Nassau owned or operated stations. The total number of stations shown in this market is six as required in Section 73.3555(a)(1)(iv) of the multiple ownership rules. Nassau will not own, operate or control more than 50% of the stations in this market. Additional in-market stations exist in this market but are not shown in order to maximize mapping clarity. Table 1 lists the stations contained in Figure 1.

METHODOLOGY

The field strength values employed for the principal community contours shown in this report are the FCC prescribed values of 5 mv/m for AM stations and 3.16 mv/m for FM stations. All technical information for the stations shown in this report was obtained from the FCC's database. Contour locations were determined in strict accordance with FCC specified procedures and are computer plotted and calculated utilizing software of known accuracy.

CONCLUSION

Nassau's acquisition of WILT would comply with the Commission's multiple ownership rules as they pertain to number of stations in a market.

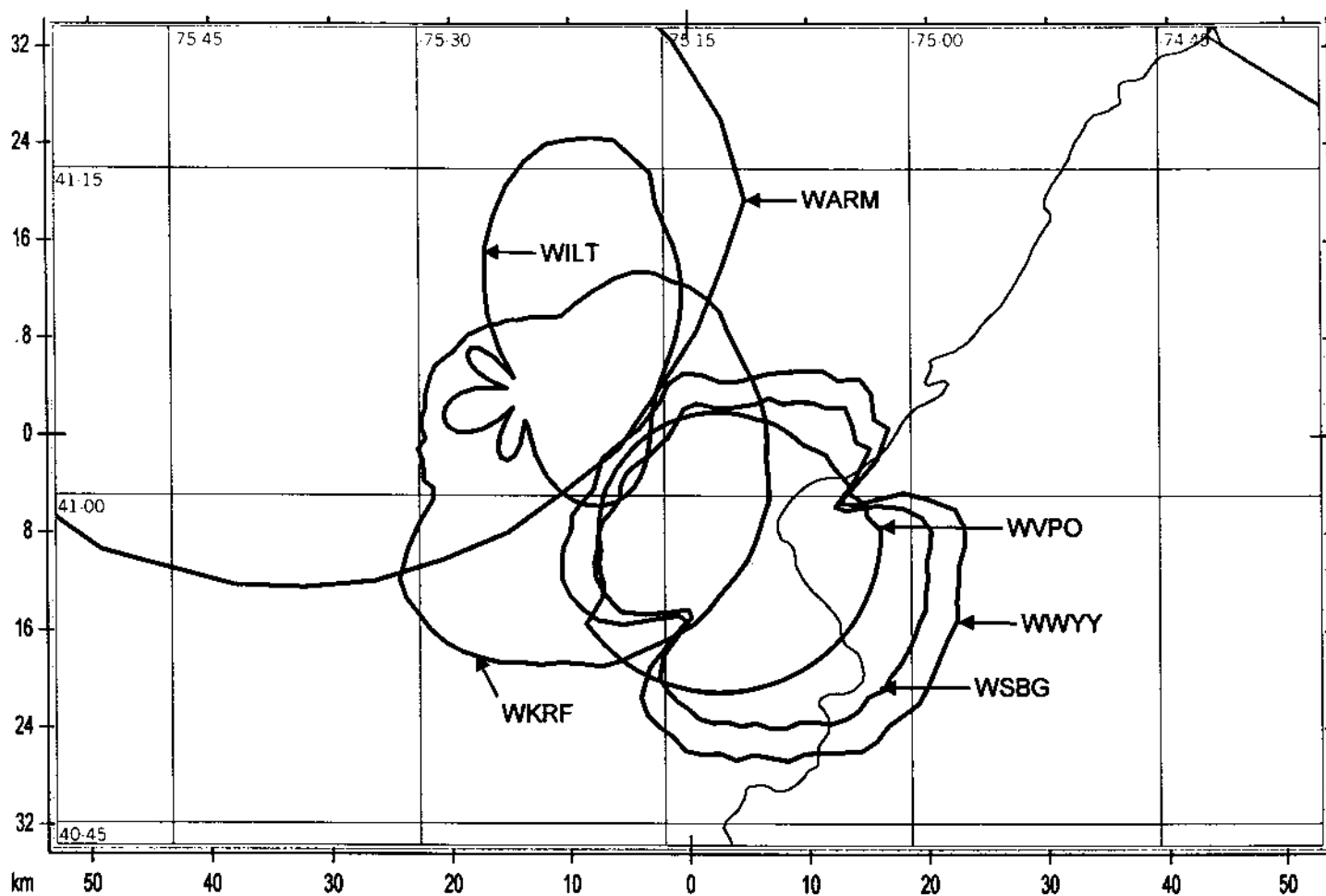
