Dear Licensee:

This is with respect to the above captioned analog station. Commission records indicate that you failed to file a license to cover by the expiration date for the station's digital construction permit – July 13, 2021. As such the station's construction permit was automatically forfeited and its underlying analog license was automatically cancelled at 12:00 A.M. (local time) on July 14, 2021.<sup>1</sup>

Accordingly, pursuant to 47 CFR §§ 74.788(b) and 74.731(m), the construction permit and license for the above captioned station were **AUTOMATICALLY FORFEITED/CANCELED** and its call sign has been **DELETED**.<sup>2</sup> All authority to operate the station has been **TERMINATED**<sup>3</sup> and any operation of the facility **MUST CEASE IMMEDIATELY**.<sup>4</sup>
