ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Nonprofit Corporation

The undersigned natural person(s) of the age of 19 years or more, acting as incorporator(s) of a corporation under the Alaska Statutes (AS 10.20) hereby executes the following document and sets forth:

Article 1. Name of the Corporation: The name of a corporation may not contain a word or phrase that indicates or implies that it is organized for a purpose other than one or more of the purposes contained in the articles of incorporation of the corporation.

Article 2. The period of duration, which may be perpetual:

Perpetual, beginning 11/01/2013

ARTICLE 3. The purpose for which the Corporation is organized:

Education: Family, Health and Spiritual

Article 4. Provisions, not inconsistent with law, which the incorporators elect to set out in the articles of incorporation for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation, including provision for distribution of assets on dissolution or final liquidation:

There are no anticipated assets associated with this nonprofit organization. If any monetary donations are received, they will be used to help defray costs incurred in the purchase and distribution of educational materials, primarily to the residents in Galena, Alaska. Should any assets be shown upon dissolution or final liquidation of this corporation, they will be donated to the Seventh-Day Adventist church in Delta Junction, Alaska, for use in their ministry.

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


