Request for Special Temporary  
Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Ms. Repp:

This letter concerns the request you filed on November 25, 2015, on behalf of President of the Liberty Church of Nevada and his Successors ("PLCNS"), for Special Temporary Authority ("STA") to permit Station KHWG-FM to remain silent.

PLCNS's request states that Station KHWG-FM went silent on November 19, 2015, because it lost its programming source. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.<sup>1</sup>

PLCNS's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station KHWG-FM to remain silent not to exceed 180 days from the date of this letter. **Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station KHWG-FM will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., November 20, 2016.**<sup>2</sup>

PLCNS is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If PLCNS does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.<sup>3</sup>

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.<sup>4</sup>
