

AMENDED EXHIBIT 5

By this application, Cox Radio, Inc. ("Cox") seeks Commission consent to implement the change in community of license for WALR-FM from Greenville, Georgia to Palmetto, Georgia. This exhibit demonstrates that the proposed modification complies with the Commission's local radio ownership rules.

Local Radio Ownership Rule

Under Section 73.3555(a) (1) of the Commission's rules, the FCC uses a tiered approach, as described below, to determine whether a combination of commonly-owned radio stations comply with the local radio ownership limits for any particular market.¹

To determine the number of stations in a market, the Commission relies on one of three methodologies:

1. Arbitron Methodology: When more than one commonly owned radio station is licensed to a community within an Arbitron Metro Market, the FCC counts the number of commercial and noncommercial radio stations that are either "home" to the Arbitron market or are licensed to a community within that market (the "Arbitron Methodology").²

2. Contour Methodology: For combinations that are licensed to communities outside an Arbitron market, the Commission defines the market as the area where the principal community contours for the commonly-owned stations overlap. To determine the number of stations in that market, the Commission counts all stations whose principal

community contours overlap that of at least one of the commonly-owned stations. The Commission, however, excludes all stations whose transmitters are greater than 92 kilometers from the mutual overlap area and any commonly owned stations that are not included already in the market (the “Contour Methodology”).³

3. Arbitron-Contour Hybrid Methodology: The FCC requires an analysis under both the Arbitron Methodology and the Contour Methodology in two situations: (i) if at least one of the commonly-owned stations is “home” to an Arbitron market but it is licensed to a community outside that market or (ii) if a station is licensed to a community within an Arbitron market but its principal community contour overlaps that of another commonly-owned station that is not licensed to a community within any Arbitron market (the “Arbitron-Contour Hybrid Methodology”).⁴

Atlanta, Georgia

WALR’s community of license, Palmetto, Georgia, is located inside the Atlanta Arbitron Metro market, and BIA classifies WALR-FM as “home” to the Atlanta Arbitron metro. Upon grant of the instant application, Cox and/or certain officers of Cox⁵ will hold an attributable interest in the following radio stations that are licensed to communities located within, near, or otherwise “home” to the Atlanta, Georgia Arbitron Metro market:

The Arbitron-Contour Methodology is appropriate for this application. According to BIA, WTSH-FM and WSRV(FM) are both "home" to the Atlanta Arbitron Metro market, but both station's communities of license are outside of all Arbitron Metro markets. Accordingly, Cox must demonstrate compliance with the local radio ownership rule using the Arbitron-Contour Hybrid Methodology.

Arbitron Methodology: The BIA Media Access Pro Database identifies 87 full-power commercial and noncommercial stations as "home" to or licensed within the Atlanta, Georgia market.⁶ Accordingly, Mr. Smith may hold an attributable interest in up to eight full-power, commercial station stations, of which five may be in the same service (AM or FM). As shown above, Mr. Smith has an attributable interest in six radio stations in the Atlanta Metro market (five FM and one AM). As such, his ownership interests comply with respect to this market.

Contour Methodology: As shown in the attached engineering exhibit from duTreil, Lundin & Rackley,⁷ Cox's and Mr. Smith's attributable interest in the above radio stations also complies with the local radio ownership rules.

Accordingly, based on the foregoing, Cox respectfully submits that its proposed modification for WALR-FM fully complies with the Commission's local radio ownership rules.

TECHNICAL STATEMENT
RADIO MULTIPLE OWNERSHIP ANALYSIS

COX RADIO, INC.

This radio multiple ownership analysis was prepared on behalf of Cox Radio, Inc. (herein "Cox"). Cox proposes in an amendment to a construction permit application to modify the facilities of WALR-FM assigned to Palmetto, Georgia (BPH-20130624ABZ). A review of the stations that Cox or its affiliates have interest was completed. Therefore, the following stations are considered under ownership or control for this analysis:

The principal community contours (3.16 mV/m for FM stations, 5 mV/m for AM stations) of the stations are depicted on a map included herein as Figure 1.* Since some of these stations have overlapping principal community contours, an ownership study was prepared in accordance with the Federal Communications Commission multiple ownership rules as outlined in Section 73.3555.

Radio Market

The "radio market" applicable to common ownership of the subject stations is defined as the area encompassed by the mutually overlapping principal community contours of the stations proposed to be commonly owned.† There are three "radio markets" defined for analysis under the Commission's Rules created by the proposed WALR-FM facility modification. The table below lists the defined market:

Count of Stations in Defined Market

The number of other radio stations in a "radio market" is determined by counting the operating stations having principal community contours that intersect the principal community contours which define the radio market, plus the subject stations that are co-owned. Only those stations located within 92 kilometers of the perimeter of the mutual overlap area of the respective defined market area were employed in the count of the stations. Commonly controlled stations were not considered in the count of stations in the defined markets. The results of the analysis are tabulated below:

Figure 2 is a tabulation of the radio stations identified in the defined radio markets tabulated above. It is noted that the tabulation is not a complete list of all of the other stations in the market, but rather enough stations to show compliance with the FCC's radio multiple ownership rules. Only known licensed, operating stations were employed for the study.

Distances to the AM coverage contours were predicted using the antenna patterns as identified in the Commission's AM database and the appropriate Ground Wave Field Strength versus Distance Graph of 47 CFR 73.184. Ground conductivity data were obtained from FCC Figure M3. Distances to the FM contours were determined based on the method of 47 CFR 73.313. Terrain data was derived from the N.G.D.C. 30-second computer database for each of the FM stations using radials evenly-spaced every 10 degrees of azimuth.

Based on the above, it is concluded that the applicant will be in compliance with the Section 73.3555(a) of the FCC Rules using the interim contour method.

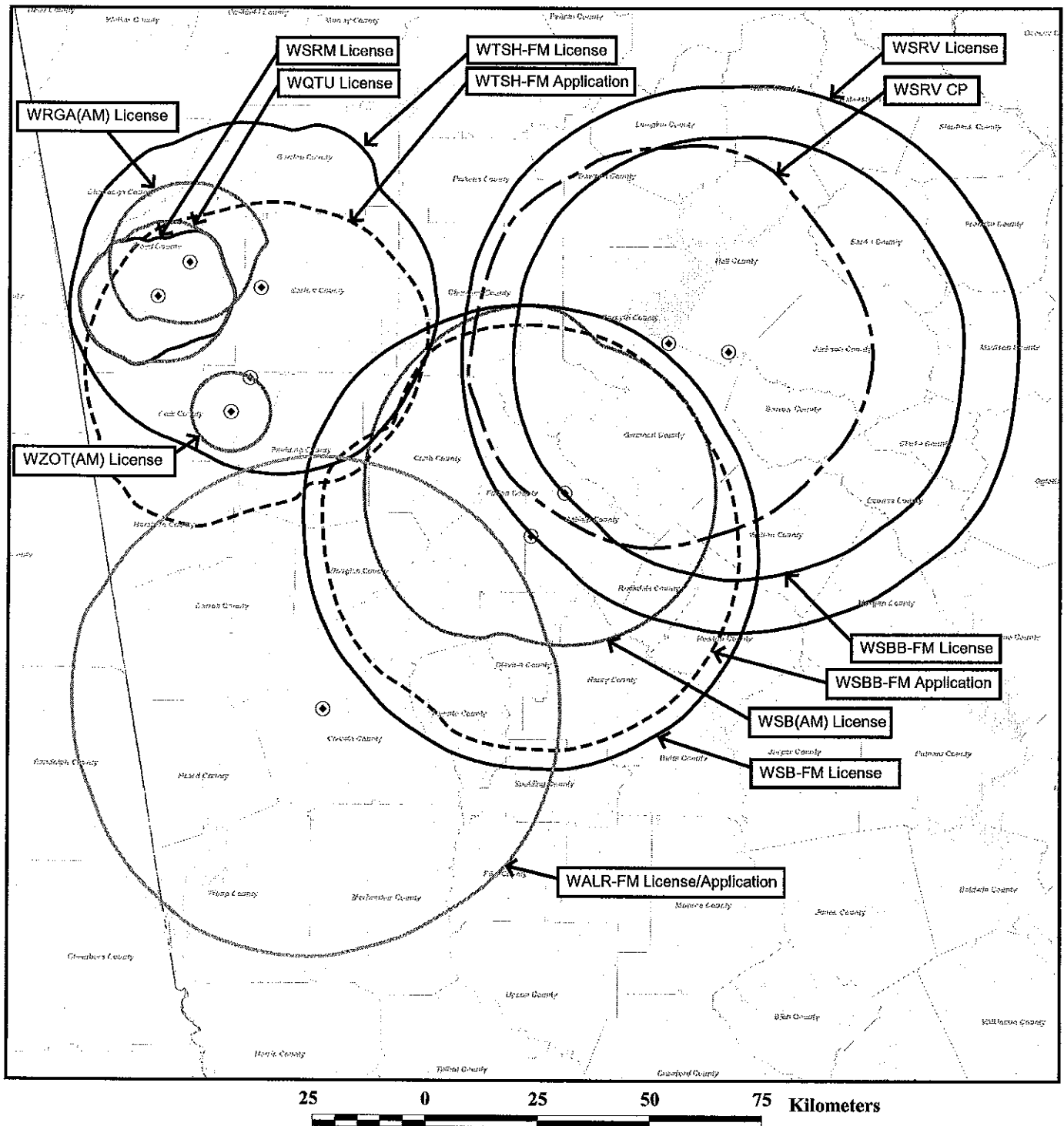
