Request for Special Temporary  
Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Mr. Parrish:

This letter concerns the request you filed on March 16, 2011, on behalf of Edgewater Broadcasting, Inc. ("EB"), for Special Temporary Authority to permit FM Translator Station W235AO to remain silent.

EB's request states that Station W235AO went silent on March 16, 2011, for financial reasons. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

EB's request will be granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station W235AO to remain silent until March 16, 2012. **Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station W235AO will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not commence by 12:01 a.m., March 17, 2012.**<sup>1</sup> See Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, 47 U.S.C. § 312(g).


The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation

Finally, we note that it is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed. *See* 47 C.F.R. §§ 17.6 and 73.1740(a)(4).
