

Community Radio, Inc., a non profit public benefit corporation, established on March 9, 2012 in the state of Arkansas, if granted a Construction Permit and subsequently a License for a Low Power FM Radio Station in Mena, Arkansas by the Federal Communications Commission, plans to use the radio station as an educational tool in the following ways:

- 1-Teach Bible knowledge using local churches and local pastors and teachers,
- 2-Teach Biblical based business principles using local churches and pastors,
- 3-Teach family and parenting skills using local churches, pastors and counselors,
- 4-Teach Christian values and Biblical truths using music,
- 5-Provide airtime for local organizations, including but not limited to Churches, for the announcement and promotion of events and activities.

Local studio and office staffed by volunteers will assist in the recording and airing of mainly locally originated education programs.

Programs will include:

Daily program time for the Ministerial Alliance,

Daily program for local churches,

Daily program to announce and promote local Christian activities, meetings etc,

Educational Christian music,

Weekly program produced locally pertaining to Christian business principles,

Weekly program produced locally pertaining to Christian educational and social opportunities,

Weekly program produced locally pertaining to Christian education,

Weekly program produced locally pertaining to Christian home schooling,

Weekly live broadcasts of church services for the purpose of educating listeners about the Bible and Christianity.
