CANADIAN BORDER

The proposed facilities are located 176 km from the Canadian border. As this distance is less than 320 km, compliance to the Working Arrangement for the Allotment and Assignment of FM Broadcasting Channels under the Agreement between the Government of Canada and the Government of the United States of America relating to the FM Broadcasting Service, effective February 25, 1991, as amended July 9, 1997 is demonstrated in this exhibit.

The following table lists all known, relevant Canadian allotments and assignments, the minimum distances between the proposed facilities and these allotments and assignments, actual distances and margins.
