*Request for Waiver of the July 7, 2006 Maximization Deadline*

Dear Ms. Dortch:

Red River Broadcast Co., LLC (“Red River”), the licensee of analog television station KVRR-TV, Channel 15, Fargo, North Dakota, Facility ID No. 55372, and the permittee of digital television (“DTV”) station KVRR-DT, Channel 19, Fargo, North Dakota, by its attorneys, hereby submits this Request for Waiver (“Request”) of the July 7, 2006 maximization deadline.<sup>1</sup> Specifically, Red River requests a six-month waiver of the maximization deadline due to reasons beyond its control.

The Commission generally requires that DTV stations comply with a July 7, 2006 “use-it-or-lose-it” deadline for replicating or maximizing their digital signals unless otherwise specified by the Commission or a request for waiver is filed.<sup>2</sup> DTV stations failing to meet that deadline face potential loss of interference protection in the future.<sup>3</sup> Absent a grant of this Request, the July 7, 2006 maximization deadline would be applicable to KVRR-DT.

In the *Second Periodic Review* in this proceeding, the Commission recognized that certain circumstances may warrant flexible enforcement of the maximization deadline. To this end, the *Second Periodic Review* adopted a waiver process to provide for six-month extensions of the maximization/replication protection deadline. In a recent *Public Notice*, the Commission provided further guidance regarding the waiver process.<sup>4</sup> The *Public Notice* requires a petitioner to demonstrate “severe financial constraints or circumstances beyond [the petitioner’s] control.”<sup>5</sup>

Red River submits that it satisfies the latter criterion. Despite its diligent efforts to comply with the July 7 deadline, Red River will be unable to meet the deadline with respect to KVRR-DT because of technical delays beyond its control. Specifically, the tower in Barnesville, Minnesota on which the KVRR-DT antenna is situated required strengthening before KVRR-DT’s maximized facilities could be constructed. As the attached letter from Midwest Steeple Jacks, Inc. demonstrates, the tower crew encountered weather delays that pushed back the time schedule for completing steel reinforcement modifications (*see Exhibit 1*).

The project has been further delayed because a tower crew must remove a Clear Channel FM antenna from the tower before another tower crew can begin the KVRR-DT maximization process. The attached letter from Sioux Falls Tower & Communications indicates that the FM tower crew is scheduled to remove the FM antenna before the week of July 23 (*see Exhibit 2*). Once the tower crew has finished removing the FM antenna, the tower crew engaged by Red River is prepared to begin construction of KVRR-DT’s maximized facilities. Red River believes that construction of KVRR-DT’s maximized facilities will be completed within six months of July 7, 2006. Accordingly, Red River respectfully requests a six month waiver of the maximization deadline owing to reasons beyond its control.

Red River has separately filed, via CDBS, requests for extension of the KVRR-DT STA authorization, FCC File No. BDSTA- 20030206ADJ, and KVRR-DT Construction Permit, FCC File No. BPCDT- 19991028ACA, for the reasons set forth herein.


