Agreements & Summary of Transaction

This Form 315 application and a companion one seek FCC consent to the transfer of control of BlueStone TV Holdings Inc. (the “Company”) (including its wholly-owned subsidiary BlueStone Television Inc. and its wholly-owned licensee subsidiaries BlueStone License Holdings Inc.¹ and Newport License Holdings Inc.,² which together are the licensees of eight full-power television stations and two LPTVs) from Transferor BlueStone Television LLC (which owns 100% of the shares of the Company) to Transferee Bonten Media Group LLC (f/k/a News Acquisition LLC) (“Bonten Media Group”). The licensees are placing in the stations’ public inspection files, and the parties are submitting with this application, a copy of the Stock Purchase Agreement (“BlueStone Purchase Agreement”) dated as of November 11 , 2006, pursuant to which Transferee Bonten Media Group would acquire all the stock of the Company from Transferor BlueStone Television LLC. As noted in Licensee Exhibit 6, certain exhibits and schedules, which are identified in Exhibit 6, are not included but may be provided to the FCC on request.

The parties request that the FCC process together the BlueStone Application and BlueStone Companion Application. The parties note that in a contemporaneous filed application, Esteem Broadcasting LLC is seeking consent to acquire the stock of Aurora Broadcasting Inc. (“ABI”), the parent of Aurora License Holdings Inc., licensee of WEMT(TV), Greenville, Tennessee (the “Aurora Application”). The Aurora Application describes certain nonattributable business arrangements between the Company and the owners of WEMT which

would be carried forward at the closing of the acquisition of the Company by Bonten Media Group.³

BlueStone License Holdings Inc. is the licensee of the following seven full-power television stations and two LPTV stations: WCYB-TV, Bristol, Virginia; KRCR-TV, Redding, California; KAEF, Arcata, California; KECI-TV, Missoula, Montana; KCFW-TV, Kalispell, Montana; KTVM, Butte, Montana; KTXS-TV, Sweetwater, Texas; KTES-LP, Abilene, Texas; and KTXE-LP, San Angelo, Texas (the “BlueStone Stations”). The instant application seeks consent to the transfer of control of the Company to Bonten Media Group as it relates to the BlueStone Stations (the “BlueStone Application”). License renewal applications are pending for the BlueStone Stations. In *Stockholders of CBS Inc.*, 11 FCC Rcd 3733 (1995), the FCC held that it may consider and act on an application for the transfer of control of multiple broadcast stations notwithstanding the pendency of any application for renewal of license of one or more of the stations subject to the transfer of control. The parties respectfully request that the FCC process the BlueStone Application pursuant to the procedures established in that decision. In that regard, Bonten Media agrees to assume the consequences associated with succeeding to the place of the existing applicant if the renewal applications for any of the BlueStone Stations are pending at the time that the parties close the transactions covered by the BlueStone Application.

2. Newport License Holdings Inc. (“Newport”), is the licensee of WCTI-TV, New Bern, North Carolina. Pursuant to an option agreement, the Company and Newport have joined in filing an FCC application seeking consent to the transfer control of Newport to the Company, under which transaction Newport would become a wholly-owned indirect subsidiary of the Company (the “Newport Application”). The BlueStone Purchase Agreement provides for the closing of this transaction before consummation of the transfer of control of the Company to Bonten Media Group. Thus, because Newport will be a subsidiary of the Company at the closing of the BlueStone Stock Purchase Agreement, the parties to the instant application have filed a companion Form 315 application for consent to the transfer of control of the Company to Bonten Media Group as its relates to the Company’s to-be-owned-at-closing licensee subsidiary Newport and its station WCTI-TV (the “BlueStone Companion Application”). (The 2005 license renewal application for WCTI-TV has been granted.)

3. The BlueStone Purchase Agreement contemplates that the transaction subject to the Aurora Application will close immediately prior to closing the transactions covered by the BlueStone Application and BlueStone Companion Application.
