Request for Extension of Special Temporary
Authority to Remain Silent

Dear Ms. Martinez:

This letter concerns the request you filed on September 18, 2017, on behalf of Hispanic Women of Poinciana Corp. (HWPC), for extension of Special Temporary Authority (STA) to permit Low Power FM Station WJRQ-LP to remain silent.

Commission records reflect that HWPC stated that Station WJRQ-LP went silent on March 11, 2017, for technical reasons. The previous STA was granted on March 24, 2017, and expired on September 20, 2017. HWPC requests extension of its STA for continuing technical reasons. The request includes the appropriate certification regarding Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988.

HWPC's request is granted. Accordingly, Special Temporary Authority is granted to permit Station WJRQ-LP to remain silent until March 11, 2018. **Notwithstanding the grant of this Special Temporary Authority, the broadcast license for Station WJRQ-LP will automatically expire as a matter of law if broadcast operations do not resume by 12:01 a.m., March 12, 2018.**¹

HWPC is required to notify the Commission when broadcast operations resume. If HWPC does not file the notification of resumption of operations in a timely manner, the license may be subject to cancellation pursuant to Section 312(g) of the Communications Act, as amended.²

The station's silent status does not suspend the licensee's obligation to comply with all other relevant Commission rules, including the filing, when appropriate, of applications for renewal of broadcast license. It is imperative to the safety of air navigation that any prescribed painting and illumination of the station's tower shall be maintained until removed.³
