ENGINEERING STATEMENT

The engineering data contained herein have been prepared on behalf of EMMIS RADIO LICENSE, LLC, licensee of KZLA-FM, Los Angeles, California, in support of its Application for License to Cover Construction Permit BPH-19980728IE, which authorized the relocation of the KZLA-FM transmitting facilities from one site to another on Mount Wilson.

There are a number of special operating conditions on the subject permit, discussed as follows:

1. KZLA-FM will continue to cooperate with other licensees on Mount Wilson to avoid excessive RF exposure to persons having access to the area.
2. KZLA-FM requests Program Test Authority for this directional facility.
- 3., 4. In a statement dated February 9, 1999, the undersigned provided data demonstrating that the proposed facility would not contribute as much as five percent of the reference RF exposure level at any location on Mount Wilson. On this basis, the condition requiring RF measurements does not apply.
5. Attached is a statement and data from the antenna manufacturer, ERI, describing the directional antenna and its pattern. This antenna is identical to the licensed directional antenna except for its vertical pattern.
6. Attached is a statement from a licensed land surveyor attesting to the orientation of the antenna.

7. Attached is the statement of Joel T. Saxberg attesting to the proper installation of the directional antenna.
8. It may be seen from the manufacturer's tabulation that maximum relative field at 35 degrees true is 0.204, which is -13.807 db or -1.135 dbk or 0.77 kw.

It should be noted that the application for this facility incorrectly showed the vertical ERP to be the same as the horizontal ERP, and this error then appeared on the subject Construction Permit. As may be seen from the directional pattern, while the maximum horizontal ERP is indeed 18.5 kw, the maximum vertical ERP is actually 16 kw.

It should also be mentioned that, due to a Forest Service moratorium on construction at Mount Wilson, tolling began approximately one year after the grant of this permit. Tolling ended in October, 2004, so this application is timely filed.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing statement and the attached exhibits are true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.
