Dear Licensee:

This refers to Low Power Television Station KBKF-LP, Glen Arbor, California. Commission records indicate that this station was issued a covering license on September 11, 2009.<sup>1</sup>

The Commission has now received a complaint that this station is not operating and may never have been constructed at and/or operated at the licensed coordinates. Specifically, a member of the public has informed the Commission that there is no evidence of an antenna and tower at that location, and that there was no on-air signal for the station on at least two days.

As part of our investigation of this matter, we require certain information regarding the construction and operation of this station. This information must be supported by affidavit of the licensee or other officer or employee with personal knowledge thereof. We request that you provide the following information and appropriate documentation within fifteen (15) business days from the date of this letter:

1. Was the above-captioned station constructed and operated in accordance with all terms, conditions and obligations set forth in its construction permit? If so, provide documentation establishing the dates on which the station operated, such as a copy of any lease agreements for use of the authorized transmitter site, agreements regarding the station's construction, and affidavits of persons responsible for the construction and continuing operation of the station. You must also provide the name and telephone number of the contact person for the transmitter site. In

the event that this station has not operated continuously, please provide any specific dates, times and duration of any interruption of the station's operations.

2. Please provide specific information describing the technical operation of the station. This information should include a description of the equipment used, the antenna and tower site, the effective radiated power, and HAAT. Please verify that all operations have been consistent with the FCC license for the station.
3. Please provide a description of the nature or type, and duration of any programming broadcast by the station.
4. Please provide the names and title and specific duties of any station personnel involved with the supervision and operation of the station.
5. Please provide the Commission with any correspondence, documents station records, or any other written material verifying the station's operations.

We direct you to support your responses with an affidavit or declaration under penalty of perjury, signed and dated by an authorized officer of the licensee with personal knowledge of the representations provided in the responses, verifying the truth and accuracy of the information therein.

Your responses should be filed within 15 days from the date of this letter. Failure to provide the requested information will result in the denial of any pending requests for authority or relief.
