

**Exhibit 13****Description: MAIN STUDIO WAIVER REQUEST**

AT THE REQUEST OF THE FCC'S STAFF, THE FOLLOWING ADDITIONAL MATERIAL IS ADDED TO EXHIBIT 13 ON FILE AS A PDF ATTACHMENT:

THE MAIN STUDIO OF KSIV-FM IS IN ST. LOUIS, MISSOURI EVEN THOUGH MUCH OF ITS PROGRAMMING IS RECEIVED BY SATELLITE FROM THE BOTT RADIO NETWORK IN OVERLAND PARK, KANSAS. PARAGRAPH 2 OF THE REVISED WAIVER REQUEST SAYS, 'THE MAIN STUDIO FOR KJCV WILL BE CO-LOCATED WITH THE MAIN STUDIO OF STATION KSIV-FM, ST. LOUIS, MISSOURI...' THUS, THERE IS A STUDIO FACILITY IN ST. LOUIS.

THE ST. LOUIS MAIN STUDIO HOUSES NOT ONLY KSIV-FM, BUT ALSO COMMONLY-CONTROLLED COMMERCIAL STATION KSIV(AM), CLAYTON, MISSOURI. THE ST. LOUIS STUDIO IS STAFFED AND HAS PROGRAM ORIGINATION CAPABILITY. THE COMMERCIALS BROADCAST ON KSIV(AM), AND LOCAL PROGRAM MATERIAL BROADCAST ON BOTH THE AM AND THE FM STATIONS ORIGINATES FROM THE ST. LOUIS STUDIO. THERE WILL BE MONITORING AND CONTROL CAPABILITY AT THE ST. LOUIS STUDIO FOR STATION KJCV AS THE RULES REQUIRE, AND CBI WILL PROVIDE THE REQUIRED MANAGEMENT AND STAFF PRESENCE.

THE PROGRAMMING BROADCAST ON STATION KJCV WILL BE LARGELY IDENTICAL TO THAT BROADCAST ON KSIV-FM. BUT, LOCAL PROGRAMMING GEARED TO COUNTRY CLUB, MISSOURI WILL BE PRODUCED AT BOTT RADIO NETWORK HEADQUARTERS IN OVERLAND PARK BASED ON THE CONTACTS DESCRIBED IN THE WAIVER REQUEST AND THEN DISTRIBUTED EXCLUSIVELY TO THE COUNTRY CLUB TRANSMITTER/ AUXILARY STUDIO SITE VIA SATELLITE WITHOUT OTHER STATIONS IN THE NETWORK RECEIVING OR BROADCASTING THOSE PROGRAMS. THIS IS DONE THROUGH A DISCRETE SATELLITE CONNECTION THAT ONLY THE COUNTRY CLUB FACILITY'S COMPUTER CAN READ.

PRODUCING THE COUNTRY CLUB STATION'S PROGRAMS IN OVERLAND PARK WILL BE MORE EFFICIENT THAN PRODUCING THEM AT THE ST. LOUIS STUDIO BECAUSE OVERLAND PARK IS 70 MILES FROM COUNTRY CLUB, AS OPPOSED TO ST. LOUIS, WHICH IS HUNDREDS OF MILES AWAY. AS STATED IN THE WAIVER REQUEST, CBI PERSONNEL IN OVERLAND PARK WILL TRAVEL TO COUNTRY CLUB AT LEAST MONTHLY AND WILL KEEP IN TOUCH WITH THE COMMUNITY BETWEEN VISITS THROUGH THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A COMMUNITY ADVISORY BOARD.
