

Explanation of Special Temporary Authority (STA) Request for the Licensed Antenna System at a Reduced Power.

KIOA(FM) - Des Moines, IA (FAC ID: 58547) is licensed under BLH-20000207ABQ with 82.0 kW ERP(H&V) of non-directional power at an antenna COR of 596 meters AMSL (305 meters AGL). KIOA(FM) presently utilizes an Electronics Research Inc. (ERI) Model G5CPS-10AC, 10-bay, half-wave spaced antenna with a Transmitter Power Output (TPO) of 17.5 kW.

On January 17, 2022, an undetermined antenna failure rendered KIOA(FM) unable to safely maintain full licensed parameters. Therefore, out of an overabundance of caution, the station is operating at 71.4% licensed power. Scheduling of a tower climber to inspect the system has occurred. However, due to the on-going Covid-19 situation, tower-firm staffing issues, and anticipated antenna-part supply chain shortage issues; the antenna inspection, diagnosis, repair and restoration of licensed operations is anticipated to take more than 30 days.

Therefore, during this period of interim operation, KIOA(FM) requests Special Temporary Authority to operate at 71.4% licensed power; or a power of 58.5 kW ERP (12.5 kW TPO) into the licensed, Electronics Research Inc. (ERI) Model G5CPS-10AC, 10-bay, half-wave spaced antenna at the licensed antenna COR of 596 meters AMSL (305 meters AGL). This STA requests a full 180 days, or six (6) months of temporary operation.

Temporary operation at a variance from the Commission's Rules is believed merited as this STA (1) seeks temporary relief from the combined provisions of 47 C.F.R. Section 73 Subpart B (73.201-73.333) and Subpart H (73.1001-73.4280); (2) serves the public interest by maintaining a KIOA(FM) service to the community of license (Des Moines, IA) as opposed to seeking silent authority; and (3) is not expected to exceed an STA duration of 180 days from the time of the STA filing until repairs and restoration of the KIOA(FM) licensed operation occurs. No change to the licensed KIOA(FM) operation is anticipated. However, if changes to the antenna, feedline or Transmitter Power Output (TPO) are encountered; the applicant will file a future Construction Permit or License Modification Application should repairs merit such a filing.

Anti-Drug Abuse Act Certification. The applicant certifies that neither the applicant nor any party to the application is subject to denial of federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1988, 21 U.S.C. Section 862.
