Notification of Pre-Transition DTV Service Termination Station KETZ-DT, El Dorado, Arkansas (Facility ID No. 92872)

The Arkansas Educational Television Commission (“AETC”) hereby notifies the Commission of its intent to terminate pre-transition digital television service for noncommercial educational television station KETZ-DT, Pre-Transition DTV Channel 12, El Dorado, Arkansas (“KETZ”) on or about January 3, 2009. This termination of pre-transition digital television service is scheduled to occur within 90 days of the February 17, 2009 DTV transition date, such that no prior authorization or Special Temporary Authority is required.

*In the Matter of Third Periodic Review of the Commission’s Rules and Policies Affecting the Conversion to Digital Television,*¹ the Commission set forth procedures for stations to conduct a planned permanent service reduction or termination (analog or digital) within 90 days of the February 17, 2009 transition date.² The *Third Periodic Review* requires that stations file a notification at least 30 days in advance, demonstrate that the reduction is necessary for purposes of the transition, and conduct viewer notifications.

In this case, the termination of pre-transition digital service for KETZ is directly related to the build-out of the KETZ post-transition digital facility. AETC will employ the KETZ pre-transition DTV antenna for use in the KETZ post-transition digital facility. In order to do so, AETC needs to make significant modifications to the pre-transition DTV antenna and transmitter, and will also relocate the antenna on an existing antenna tower. This will require termination of KETZ’s pre-transition DTV service for some period of time starting on or about January 3, 2009, possibly until the DTV transition date.

AETC will conduct on-viewer notifications regarding the early termination of analog and pre-transition digital television service for KETS in accordance with the *Third Periodic Review*.
