Nature and Educational Purpose of Latino Public Radio

By this application, Latino Public Radio (“LPR”) proposes to acquire the license of WRNI(AM), Providence, Rhode Island, Facility ID 48308 (“WRNI” or the “Station”) in order to continue and enhance the Station’s educational mission. WRNI is a Spanish-language public radio station that LPR has programmed for nearly six years pursuant to a programming agreement.

LPR is a 501(c)(3) not-for-profit organization, whose mission is to inform, educate and entertain the bilingual radio audience through the production and distribution of intelligent, high quality, cultural and educational programming that reflects the diversity of the Latino community.

Since LPR’s inception in 2005, the station has presented itself to the community as a resource to protect and project the values of the Rhode Island Latino community. LPR’s team of strong dedicated members is comprised by renowned professionals and community leaders who are committed to the Latino community striving to educate and inform our listeners. Its focus is to bring its audience intelligent discussion about salient issues of the day that impact the Latino community. These include health, politics, business, financial services, and education.

LPR believes that radio is the best way to effectively reach the Latino community. Its commitment to educate the community about their health has always been an important part of its mission. For instance, one recent initiative was “El Aprendiz Medico,” where LPR forged a new partnership between the Warren Alpert Medical School at Brown University and Women & Infants Hospital to invite students focusing on obstetrics and gynecology to produce the contents and be interviewed on the radio show as part of their hospital clerkships. Furthermore, with The Rhode Island Foundation’s support, LPR has developed a radio series called “Sin Seguro” to emphasize the importance of primary care and highlight and disseminate information about resources for those who have no insurance coverage in Rhode Island.

LPR also has a strong focus on breaking news and covering historical events in Rhode Island, including coverage of health fairs, primary and general elections, and press conferences of general importance to our community.

LPR’s vision is to continue making a difference to those we serve in Rhode Island and expand its educational programming to other Latino communities in the United States.
