This letter will serve to explain the circumstances that result in the request for the STA for the proposed facilities.

The Class A licensee KSKJ was operating on channel 38 as indicated on his license. KPXN-D (FCC file number BMPCDT20021126AAU) has begun test and operations on channel 38 and as a result, the viewing audience of KSKJ has been reduced to effectively nothing. In essence, KSKJ-CA has been displaced and receiving significant interference.

To resolve the interference, this firm has filed a displacement application with the FCC (FCC file #20050714ACI This STA requests the immediate granting of operation that matches the facilities described in the application. Namely, the proposed facilities of a Pineapple UTV-1KW transmitter (slightly reduced in power and within the type certified range), transmission line, and Scala 2X2 723147 panel antenna will result in an ERP of 8 kW on the horizon.

This STA request is believed to be in the public interest because it will allow KSKJ to serve its intended audience. Furthermore, the STA is only requested until the minor license application for KSKJ-CA identified above is granted. The attached interference analysis is exactly the same as filed with the application as well as the attached RF Exposure prediction.
