This letter is in reference to the above captioned application filed by Entercom to change site, and collocate with station KCCV(AM) using three of the existing towers.

A preliminary review of the application reveals that the nighttime proposal will increase the 50% RSS limit towards Mexican stations XENR, Nueva Rosita, Coahila, and XENVA2, Ojinaga, Chihuahua, in violation of the U.S/Mexican Agreement. Entercom is aware of this issue and indicated in the application that the proposal represents a reduction in the licensed KMBZ 50% RSS contribution. However, the FCC's International Bureau has confirmed that Mexico previously objected to the licensed KMBZ nighttime 5 kW directional facility (Change list # 01851, dated April 15, 1982), and therefore Entercom may not use the licensed facility to meet the required protection to these Mexican facilities. As a result, Entercom has two possible options at this point in time: (1) file a formal letter with the Commission requesting that the Audio Division hold further action on this application until after Mexico responds back to the FCC's International Bureau staff; or (2) amend the application to fully protect all Mexican stations.

Further action will be withheld for thirty (30) days from the date of this letter to amend or respond. Failure to amend or respond within that time period will result in dismissal of the application pursuant to Section 73.3568 of the Commission's rules.
