Dear Mr. Perdomo:


The staff has under consideration: (1) the above-captioned application for K248BD¹ for Hemphill, Texas; (2) the *Informal Objection* filed by James Davis ("Petitioner") filed on August 16, 2017; (3) and all related pleadings. For the reasons set forth herein, we deny the Informal Objection and grant the application.

Petitioner alleges that K248BD installed a different antenna, single bay BKG-77, than specified in the application. The applicant states, in the *Opposition to Informal Objection* filed October 19, 2017, that the single bay BKG-77 was installed on a temporary basis for testing. The applicant has certified that the specified antenna in the application has been ordered and will be installed.

The application for K248BD, BMPFT-20170814ABL, complies with all relevant rules and regulations. Since the Petitioner has not cited any rule violations, we will deny the Informal Objection.

Accordingly, the Informal Objection filed on August 16, 2017 by Petitioner IS HEREBY DENIED, the application BMPFT-20170814ABL IS HEREBY GRANTED. These actions is taken pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 0.283.
