This letter is with respect to Station KXTN-FM, San Antonio, Texas (FCC Facility ID No. 67064), which is licensed to Tichenor License Corporation ("TLC"), a subsidiary of Hispanic Broadcasting Corporation.


As the Commission's records will reflect, Station KXTN-FM is authorized by the Commission to operate as a Class C station, with antenna height above average terrain of 448 meters. Because Station KXTN-FM operates with antenna height above average terrain of less than 451 meters, it is subject to possible reclassification as a Class C0 station upon the filing of a "triggering application" for a construction permit filed by the licensee of another station that proposes a facility that would be short-spaced to KXTN-FM as a Class C station, but fully spaced to KXTN-FM as a Class C0 station. See Section 73.3573, Note 4.

TLC understands that Simmons Lone Star Media, Ltd. ("Simmons"), licensee of Station KTND(FM), Georgetown, Texas (FCC Facility ID No. 55475), intends to file with the Commission an application for a construction permit to change the station's transmitter site to a location identified by the co-ordinates 30 degrees 37 minutes 22 seconds NL; 97 degrees 38 minutes 33 seconds WL (and HAAT of 154.8 meters and ERP of 10.5 KW) which would be short-spaced to Station KXTN-FM as a Class C facility, but fully-spaced to Station KXTN-FM as a Class C0 facility.

This letter is to advise the Commission that TLC has no objection to the reclassification of Station KXTN-FM as a Class C0 facility, contingent on the Commission's grant of the Station KTND facilities modification application.

TLC is providing Simmons with a copy of this letter, and has authorized it to include the letter in the application which it submits to the Commission to obtain authority to modify the facilities of Station KTND as explained herein.
