

Showing Compliance With Section 73.3555(a) of the Commission's Rules

This application proposes the assignment of license of WWWW(FM), Marathon, Florida from Gary L. Violet to LSM Radio Partners LLC ("LSM Radio"). There is a concurrently filed assignment of license application for WAVK(FM) from Clear Channel Broadcasting Licenses, Inc. to LSM Radio. The principals of LSM Radio will have an attributable ownership interest in WAVK(FM) upon consummation of the assignment of the station's license to LSM Radio. There is an overlap of the 70 dBu contours between licensed facilities of WWWW(FM) and WAVK(FM) as well as the licensed facilities of WAVK(FM) and the permitted facilities of WWWW(FM). Thus, there are two markets for consideration which are defined by the overlap of the WAVK(FM) and WWWW(FM) 70 dBu contours.

As demonstrated in the engineering statement of LSM Radio's engineer (attached to this Exhibit), the principal community contours of at least 6 stations overlap the principal community contours of WWWW(FM) and WAVK(FM) for both markets. Under Section 73.3555(a)(1)(iv) of the Commission's rules, a party may own up to five commercial radio stations in a market of this size, provided that no more than three of the stations are in the same service and the new licensee will not own more than 50 percent of the stations in the market. LSM Radio's proposed ownership of WWWW(FM) and WAVK(FM) will result in common ownership of two FM stations. This is far less than 50 percent of the market and thus complies with the Commission's local ownership rules.
