TECHNICAL STATEMENT

This Technical Statement and attached exhibits were prepared on behalf of Radio Training Network, Inc. ("RTN"), licensee of WLFS, Channel 220A, Port Wentworth, Georgia. RTN herein proposes to make minor changes in the facilities of WLFS by relocating the station, increasing the effective radiated power and height above average terrain and upgrading to Channel 220C3. It is noted that this instant application is being filed contingently with a minor change application submitted by Communications Capital Company II of Georgia, LLC ("CCC"), licensee of WSKX, Channel 222C2, Hinesville, Georgia. CCC is proposing to relocate WSKX from its licensed site to a new location which would not meet the Commission's minimum distance separation requirements to the licensed site of WLFS, but does comply with spacing requirements to the WLFS location specified herein.

RTN is proposing to locate WLFS on a new tower, therefore, the Federal Aviation Administration ("FAA") was apprised of this proposal. Once the FAA issues a Determination of No Hazard, the tower will be registered with the Commission. All exhibits called for on FCC Form 340, Section VII, are attached hereto. All other exhibits used to certify the application have been forwarded to RTN and are available for submission to the Commission upon request.
