This concerns the above-referenced applications for new digital low power television stations at Santa Barbara, California, filed by Point Broadcasting Company (Point) and Channel 51 of San Diego, Inc. (Channel 51). You have submitted a settlement agreement to resolve the mutual exclusivity among these applications. Pursuant to the settlement agreement, the parties have agreed that Channel 51's application will be dismissed in exchange for reimbursement of its legitimate and prudent expenses and for Point's application to be granted. These actions will resolve the mutual exclusivity among the only applications in MX Group 11.
