Dear Mr. Liu:

This is in reference to the request filed on November 30, 2018. MRBL requests a further extension of the STA granted on November 30, 2015, to continue to operating ND at the WNSW/WPAT transmitter site pending further action on BP-20181130AAH (due to loss of the licensed site).¹ In support of the request, MRBL stated that it now plans to build and license the proposed facility, but MRBL also noted that further action on the AM Revitalization proceeding might require the cancellation of this license or the related license for expanded band station WWRU (ID#87123).

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

¹ WJDM(AM) is licensed for ND operation on 1530 kHz with 1 kW day and 0.67 kW critical hours, and BP-201891130AAH proposes a new transmitter site and ND antenna system.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA is GRANTED, and MRBL may continue to operate using a maximum of 0.25 kW daytime only and one of the existing WNWS/WPAT towers (ASRN #1241949). MRBL must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. *See* 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **June 5, 2019**.
