Dear Mr. Bradshaw:

West Virginia Radio Corporation of the Alleghenies ("WV Radio Corp. of the Alleghenies"), licensee of FM Translator W229CM, Martinsburg, West Virginia (Facility ID No. 154324) ("W229CM"), by its undersigned counsel, hereby requests a one-week extension of time, through August 14, 2017, to respond to your letter dated July 6, 2017 (1800B3-PPD), in connection with the interference complaint filed by Greencastle-Antrim Education Foundation, licensee of Low Power FM WRGG-LP, Greencastle, Pennsylvania (Facility ID No. 197436) ("WRGG-LP").

In light of the ongoing efforts in resolving each listener interference complaint filed against W229CM, the large amount of time counsel and W229CMs' engineering consultants have devoted towards this week's FM translator auction filing window, and the recent travel schedules for W229CM's Vice President/Engineering and its engineering consultants, a brief extension is warranted and will best serve the Commission's objectives in receiving a complete and accurate response to WRGG-LP's interference complaint. W229CM's Vice President/Engineering has

made significant progress in addressing the individual listener complaints. However, additional time is required to address the remaining listeners, and compile the results.

Furthermore, in a good faith effort to resolve WRGG-LP's interference issues, W229CM has temporarily reduced its operational power by 50% while its Vice President/Engineering and its engineering consultants work to resolve all interference issues raised by WRGG-LP in its complaint. The reduction in power, however, has resulted in a loss of a substantial portion of W229CM's listenership.

Accordingly, for the reasons set forth above, WV Radio Corp. of the Alleghenies respectfully requests that the Commission grant it an extension through August 14, 2017, to respond completely and accurately to WRGG-LP's interference complaint.
