ALLOTMENT OF CHANNEL 213A TO LACEYVILLE, PA

1. The new community of license proposed in this application does not have another broadcast facility licensed to it. Laceyville had a population of 396 persons based on the listing in the 2000 US Census. Laceyville is located within Wyoming, PA and is not within any Urbanized area. Enclosed here is supporting information that shows that Laceyville, PA is a community for allotment purposes. No "Tuck" analysis is required because this community and the coverage area within this proposal are not within an Urbanized area.

2. Laceyville, PA has its own U.S. post office and zip code "18623". Laceyville has its own phone exchange within the 570 area code; "869". Laceyville has a church: "The Braintrim Baptist Church". Laceyville has a number of local businesses with its name within the name of the businesses including; "Laceyville Hardware", and "Laceyville Floorcovering". Laceyville has a number of other local businesses

including "Whipple's Building Materials", "Eb's Market", "The Wiser Choice Restaraunt", "Sheldon Funeral Home", and "Bluhm's Gas Service". Laceyville has its own school; "The Laceyville Elementary School". Laceyville has a volunteer fire department, "The Laceyville Goodwill Fire Company". Laceyville has its sewer authority; "The Laceyville Borough Joint Municipal Sewer Authority". Laceyville has its own police department. Laceyville is a borough within PA with its own local government including borough council members and a mayor.
