Dear Applicant:

By letters dated February 11, 2011, the staff dismissed the above-referenced application for construction permit for a new digital low power television station at Delphil, Indiana because the proposed transmitter site was located within 121 km of the reference coordinates of Indianapolis, Indiana.¹ Landover 2 LLC ("Landover") filed a timely petition for reconsideration, stating that it did not intend to specify a site within the prohibited area, and requesting reinstatement of its application so that it can amend to propose a compliant site.

In view of the foregoing, the petition for reconsideration filed by Landover IS GRANTED and the above-referenced application IS REINSTATED. Landover is directed to amend to specify a new site within 30 days of the date of this letter.
