Dear Applicant:

On April 5, 2011, the licensee as addressed above was sent a deficiency letter outlining the following interference problem:

Our preliminary engineering review reveals that your proposed facility does not comply with the Commission's interference rules. Specifically, the proposal is predicted to cause interference to the following facilities:

1. It causes objectionable interference to the protected area of the Land Mobile service in HOUSTON, TX on Channel 17

You were given the opportunity to file a minor amendment to resolve the specified interference problems within (30) days from the date of that letter. Amendments must be filed electronically. If not so amended, your application will be considered incomplete and subsequently dismissed.

Our records show that an amendment was filed on May 5, 2011, to resolve the above mentioned interference issue. Our current engineering analysis with the amended specification shows that the above referenced interference problem still exist; therefore, the above referenced modification application is considered incomplete and IS HEREBY DISMISSED.
