Dear Counsel/Licensee:

This is with respect to the Petition for Reconsideration ("Petition") filed by Entravision Holdings, LLC ("Entravision"), seeking reconsideration of the grant of a digital flash cut construction permit application (File No. BDCCDVL-20140611ACE, "DFC application") and dismissal of a digital companion channel construction permit application (File No. BDCCDTL-20131010ADG, "DCC application"). Entravision contends that the Commission's action was erroneous and requests that the DFC application grant be rescinded and application subsequently dismissed, and the DCC application be reinstated for processing "on an expedited basis." For the foregoing reasons, we grant in part, and deny in part Entravision's Petition. We also grant Entravision's Request for Leave to file a Supplement.

On October 10, 2014, Entravision simultaneously filed the DCC application and requested that the pending DFC application be dismissed. On November 19, 2014, the Commission granted the DFC application and changed the status of the DCC application to "facility void." On December 18, 2014, Entravision filed a timely Petition. Four days later, the Commission modified the status of the DCC application from "facility void" to "dismissed." On December 24, 2014, Entravision filed a Request for Leave and Supplement to its Petition reiterating its objection to the Commission's action with regard to the DCC application and request to reinstate the DCC application. Based on these fact and circumstances, we find that it is appropriate to rescind the grant for and dismiss the DFC application, as well as reinstate the DCC application. Conversely, we deny Entravision's request for expedited processing as it has not set forth any basis to support this request.

Accordingly, the Request for Leave filed by Entravision **IS HEREBY GRANTED** and the Petition for Reconsideration, filed by Entravision, **IS HEREBY GRANTED IN PART, AND DENIED IN PART**. By our action today, we **RESCIND** the grant for and **DISMISS** File No. BDCCDVL-20140611ACE. We also **REINSTATE** to pending status File No. BDCCDTL-20141010ADG.
