Dear Mr. Warshaw:

This is in reference to the request filed on October 19, 2018. UBN requests a further extension of the STA granted on January 19, 2016, to continue operating with parameters at variance pending further action on BMML-20170501ACS filed to update all operating parameters.<sup>1</sup> In support of its request, UBN stated that the application remains on hold at this time to allow time for consummation of the related assignment application (BAL-20180912AAA) and payment of all red light fees.

Requests for extension of STA will be granted only where the licensee can show that one or more of the following criteria have been met:

- Restoration of licensed facilities is complete and testing is underway;
- Substantial progress has been made during the most recent STA period toward restoration of licensed operation; or
- No progress has been made during the most recent STA period for reasons clearly beyond the licensee's control, and the licensee has taken all possible steps to expeditiously resolve the problem.

<sup>1</sup> WVNJ(AM) is licensed for DA operation on 1160 kHz with 20 kW day and 2.5 kW night.

Accordingly, the request for extension of STA IS HEREBY GRANTED, and UBN may continue to operate with parameters at variance based upon the information provided in BMML-20170501ACS. UBN must use whatever means are necessary to protect workers and the public from exposure to radio frequency radiation in excess of the Commission's exposure guidelines. See 47 CFR § 1.1310.

This authority expires on **May 18, 2019**.
