**Re: Request for Special Temporary Authority
Radio Station WZGC(FM), Atlanta, GA. (Fac. ID 13805)**

Dear Sir:

Infinity Broadcasting Corporation of Atlanta, (Infinity), licensee of radio station WZGC, Atlanta, GA, hereby requests Special Temporary Authority to operate with temporary facilities.

The main antenna for WZGC suffered major damage and must be repaired or replaced. Infinity is currently operating using an emergency antenna from a site that has already been approved for an auxiliary facility for WZGC. A data sheet and contour plot is attached listing the operating parameters of the emergency facility and to illustrate that the 60 dBu contour of the emergency facility does not exceed the licensed WZGC 60 dBu contour. Infinity was un-prepared to operate with facilities already approved in the Construction Permit already granted for an auxiliary facility.

The proposed temporary transmitting facilities will comply with the FCC guidelines limiting human exposure to radio frequency energy. If work is done on the tower in an area where over exposure could occur, the Licensee in coordination with the other users will take necessary action to prevent the overexposure of workers on the tower including reducing the transmitting power or ceasing operation completely. An Environmental Assessment is not required, as grant of this application would not be considered a major environmental action.

Enclosed is a completed FCC Form 159 in payment of the requisite \$150.00 filing fee. I am authorized to certify that no party to this application is subject to a denial of federal benefits pursuant to Section 5301 of the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1998, 21 U.S.C. § 862.
