Request for Clarification


Dear Counsel:

This letter is in reference to a November 9, 2012, Request for Clarification filed by WLII/WSUR License Partnership, G.P. ("WLII/WSUR"), licensee of WUKQ-FM ("WUKQ"), Mayaguez, Puerto Rico. WLII/WSUR requests that the Commission clarify that the parties to this proceeding may have until December 26, 2012, to effectuate the requirements of the October 22, 2012 Letter Decision, 27 FCC Rcd No. XX (MB Oct. 22, 2012) (DA 12-1688) ("Letter Decision").

The Letter Decision, *inter alia*, extended the Special Temporary Authority ("STA") of WPRM-FM, San Juan, Puerto Rico ("WPRM"), to operate on Channel 253B until November 21, 2012. WLII/WSUR states that it is working diligently toward a December 26, 2012, deadline set forth in an agreement (the "Agreement") among WLII/WSUR, Idalia Arzuaga, *et al.*, Executrix, Estate of Jose J. Arzuaga ("Estate"), WZOL, Inc., ("WZOL") and Amor Radio Group ("Amor") (collectively, "Proponents") for commencing operations of its modified facilities on Channel 254B and to finalize other regulatory and legal requirements related to a series of coordinated channel and community reassignments. WLII/WSUR contends that a brief extension of time of the WPRM STA, to December 26, 2012, is necessary to permit WUKQ to continue operations on Channel 256B until the deadline agreed to by the Proponents. It claims that this will avoid a disruption in service to WUKQ listeners and significant advertising revenue losses. Finally, WLII/WSUR notes that it is authorized to state that WZOL and Amor support this request, that Arso Radio Corporation, which will receive reimbursement of certain expenses pursuant to the Agreement, will not interpose an objection to it, and that the Estate does not object to WUKQ delaying activation of its modified facilities until December 26, 2012.

We find that grant of the Request for Clarification is in the public interest. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED, that the STA IS EXTENDED to December 26, 2012. As a result of this action, (1) WUKQ will be permitted to commence operation on Channel 254B in lieu of Channel 256B on December 26, 2012; (2) the WUKQ and Amor construction permits will be reissued effective December 26, 2012; (3) WPRM's Special Operating Condition 5 for Channel 256B (File No. BPH-20060330AAF) will remain in effect until December 26, 2012; and (4) the licenses of WIDI(FM), Quebradillas, Puerto Rico, WZOL(FM), Las Piedras, Puerto Rico, and WQML(FM), Culebra, Puerto Rico will be issued effective December 26, 2012.
