Gentlemen:

This refers to your attorney's letter dated April 14, 2014 requesting special temporary authority to remain silent. You indicate that Morning Star Broadcasting, LLC will be replacing the station's transmitter, antenna and associated equipment within the coming months due to equipment problems. You request authority to remain silent while the licensee is working to make the necessary repairs.

In light of the above, special temporary authority to remain dark pursuant to Sections 73.1740 of the Commission's Rules until October 24, 2014 IS GRANTED.

During this period of discontinued operation, you are directed to pay strict attention to Section 73.1740 (a) (4). That is, you must continue to adhere to the requirements in your station license pertaining to the lighting of antenna structures.

We wish to point out that an extension of this request must include detailed reasons and a description of efforts being taken to return the station to full power operation.
