As stated in its Articles of Incorporation, the First Baptist Church was founded as a non-profit religious educational organization in 1956. Its mission is to provide individual, family, and community support to the citizens of Monticello through the educational opportunities provided. Residents meet consistently for Biblical instruction and discussion.

The following recaps the people of our community and contributing factors to our environment and existing programs. It also identifies opportunities in which an LPFM station could assist First Baptist Church in better reaching its goals.

### *Our Community*

Located in a unique Utah valley, Monticello is the home to a wide variety of families and individuals. Some families have lived in the area for generations, while others have migrated here seeking the less hectic pace of the larger cities. Our town boasts a large tourist industry. We are known in the southern Utah area for our pristine canyons, and approximately 2,000 people call Monticello “home.”

First Baptist Church plans to utilize the LPFM station to increase the effectiveness of our educational purpose in the following areas:

### **Education**

- Though small and very geographically isolated, we are busy!
  - local news and community highlights
  - special focus on local environmental issues
- We live in an area surrounded by state forest, parks and federal lands
  - weekly or bi-weekly programming led by a local Forestry official
- Fire safety and medical emergency information
  - regular programming led by the Fire Marshal
- We have a vast resource in our children
  - educational programs by local teachers extending the current curriculum in schools
  - weekly Children’s Story Hour
  - local interest stories geared toward children
- Educational broadcasts in the History and Practice of the Christian Tradition
  - live and recorded worship services
  - weekly bulletin services updating listeners about current trends
- Calendar and regular posting of concerns / outreach / other opportunities in the Monticello community
