At the time it filed the application for a new FM translator to operate on Channel 293 at Yreka, California (BNPFT-20030811AGL), the permittee, Family Life Broadcasting, Inc. ("FLBI"), was the licensee of the proposed primary station, noncommercial educational FM Station KDOV, Medford, Oregon. On November 18, 2003, FLBI and UCB-USA, Inc. entered into an Asset Purchase Agreement (the "Agreement") that provided for the assignment of license of Station KDOV to UCB-USA, Inc., as well as the assignments of any Construction Permits issued by the Commission pursuant to certain pending applications for new translator stations listed on Exhibit A to the Agreement, including the Yreka application. The purchase price for the assignments of Station KDOV and its existing and new translators was \$750,000.

The parties filed the KDOV assignment application on November 25, 2003 (the "Assignment Application") (BALED-20031125AHM). By action dated January 16, 2004, the Commission granted the Assignment Application, which includes a copy of the Agreement. The assignment of Station KDOV to USB-USA, Inc. was consummated on March 31, 2004.

This application for assignment of the Construction Permit for Station K293AU is filed pursuant to the Purchase Agreement, a copy of which is on file with the Commission. There are no other agreements or understandings between the parties relating to Station K293AU.

UCB-USA, Inc. has certified to FLBI that a copy of the Purchase Agreement is maintained in the KDOV public file.
